\*Homeowners may do electrical work without a license only in the home they own & live in

\*Homeowners still need a permit and inspection of work for code and safety reasons

\*Homeowners may not install electrical work in a new dwelling, since they are not living in it at the time of construction

**\* All Appliances Must be Installed for Final Inspection**
