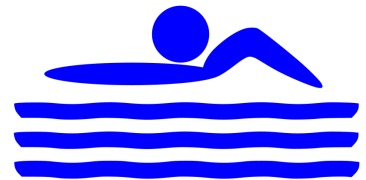

## 2017 Summer Gretna Swimming Pool Season Opening Soon

The pool will open on Saturday, May 27<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 pm for the summer. The swimming lesson fee per session is \$30.00 per person. To accommodate the growing popularity of the swim lessons, we have had to make a few changes to the times lessons are offered. This summer, swim lessons will still be 45 minutes but starting at 8:30 a.m., 9:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. The following are the session dates being offered:



- Session 1: June 5 – June 16
- Session 2: June 19 – June 30
- Session 3: July 10 – July 21
- Session 4: July 24 – Aug 4

You must now sign up for swim lessons and pool parties at the Gretna Pool. Pool passes may be purchased at City Hall starting May 1<sup>st</sup> from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. The fee continues to be \$25 per person for a pool pass. This year's pool managers will be Nick Fabry and Carter Hunter.

## ***Irrigation***

The City of Gretna wants to remind you that the irrigation season is coming soon. If you program your irrigation system, please be aware how often the system runs and how long each session takes. During the summer months, irrigation is by far the largest single user of water in the community. This will be reflected in higher water bills. Try to be aware of your irrigation session so you are managing this important resource. It is also important to look for leaks and adjust the sprinkler heads in your system so that the water goes where you want it to go.
